2018 has been a foundational year for Cherokee. COED continued to turn strategy into action by launching the first-ever Cherokee By Choice (CBC) investment campaign. The public-private partnership boasted 74 investors and over \$2.5 million pledged over five years. This support from community and industry leaders confirms the success that COED and our partners have accomplished year after year, and 2018 was no different.

COED revealed the CBC branding, a public-facing image to connect key target areas that COED focuses on to foster economic growth. The brand was launched along with an interactive website complete with a clearinghouse for Cherokee businesses from corporate to startup to announce career positions and highlight recruitment resources.

The recruitment resources included the first-ever Cherokee Workforce Collaborative's summer internship program for high school juniors and seniors to gain experience with partnering industries. The program's inaugural year had 13 participating interns and one was hired upon completion of the program.

Fresh Start Cherokee also launched a new program, the Kauffmann-backed 1 Million Cups Cherokee. This bi-monthly event carried the banner for entrepreneurship and community throughout 2018.

COED's Camera-Ready program also showcased the multiple opportunities Cherokee has to offer as well. Film production inquiries increased by 44 percent over the previous year. Wes Hagan and Kevin Dowling of the location management team for the hit Netflix series *Ozark* received an award for "Outstanding Locations in a Contemporary Television Series."

Cherokee's expanding industries also reached major milestones this year. Governor Deal cut the ribbon at the grand opening of the adidas SPEEDFACTORY. Woodstock Furniture Outlet moved into its new headquarters and distribution facility at Cherokee 75 Corporate Park, and Chart Industries relocated its headquarters to Airport Commerce Center. Northside Hospital Cherokee expanded its brand-new facility, and WellStar began construction on its Cherokee Health Park at Holly Springs which is set to open in the summer of 2019.

Mixed-use is a target sector within the Cherokee By Choice strategy. COED is working to promote mixed-use development along the Cherokee 75 Corridor, Cherokee's cities, and around the airport area.



Tucked between miles of greenspace and downtown Canton, the Canton Textile Mill will soon be transformed into Greater Atlanta's next mixed-use destination: The Mill On Etowah. Future home to retail shops, restaurants, residences, and office space, the 30-acre redevelopment will revitalize the gateway to Canton's city center while preserving its historic past.

ACADEMY & MAIN

Academy & Main is Canton's newest mixeduse development, offering office, restaurant, and retail space. Academy & Main breathes fresh life into Canton's historic buildings for a true live, work, play experience.

The Holly Springs Town Center will truly be a "live, work, play" project. Housing options will include lofts, townhomes, and cottage homes. With ample room for retail and office space, the Holly Springs Town Center will also feature an event green overlooking the new City Hall.
